Dear Parents, Carers and Friends of the Benalla P-12 College Community,

Return to school

Thankyou to all parents for what has been a smooth transition back to school so far. We really appreciate the way you have respected the guidelines about not entering the school grounds and dropping children off at the gate. Please remember to maintain physical distancing outside the school at the end of the day to ensure that the footpath is clear for students to walk safely along. Students have made the transition back to face to face schooling very well, quickly slipping back into routine and focusing on their learning. It is great to see students in full school uniform each day, looking like they belong at school and are ready to learn.

We are very much looking forward to having the rest of our students back on-site next Tuesday June 9th. The same guidelines will apply about dropping students off at the gate and collecting them from outside at the end of the day. Updated details and these drop-offs and pick-ups will be published on Compass later this week.

Friday June 5th

Just a reminder to all parents that this Friday June 5th is a student free day so that staff can write reports. This was approved by school council earlier this year. There will be no classes or on-site supervision of students of any year level. There will however, be care offered at the Waller Street Campus through our afterschool care service. Booking are essential for this and should be made by contacting Kerry Masters at school.

Loaned Devices

Over the past 7 weeks, we have loaned out hundreds of devices including laptops, iPads and internet dongles. As students return to school we ask that these devices please be returned. This will allow us to put the devices back to use at school in class sets or trolleys that can be booked by staff.

Secondary students who have a laptop should bring the device with them to school each day and take it to class. They will be notified of a time when they are to return it to the IT team. It may not happen straight away so they may then bring the laptop home again, in which case they should bring it back to school the following day.

Primary students with iPads should return them to their campus as of next Tuesday June 9^{th} .

Internet dongles should also be returned with the device by the student. If you had a dongle and no laptop/iPad, please return the dongle to the office with your child as they come back to school.

Any music student can post an item – serious or funny – and receive a free NEVR music camp 2020 T-shirt and Drink bottle in the mail. (pic attached)



Out of School Hours Care Please note that there is a dress code for our Vacation Care Program.

CSEF: CAMPS, SPORT & EXCURSION FUND

PARENTS PLEASE NOTE:

If you have had a change of circumstances recently and now hold a Current Concession Card, you may be able to access the CSEF Fund. Please read below eligibility and if this applies to you come into the school office for an application form. If you have already applied you don't need to apply again.

Eligibility

Below is the criteria used to determine a student's eligibility for the CSEF

To be eligible for the fund, a parent or legal guardian of a student attending a registered government or non-government Victorian primary or secondary school must

- a) be a holder of Veterans Affairs Gold Card or be an eligible Centrelink Health Care Card (HCC) or Pensioner Concession Card (PCC) holder or
- b) be a temporary foster parent and
- c) submit an application to the school by the 19 June 2020.

The CSEF is an **annual payment** to the school to be used towards camps, sports and/or excursion expenses for the benefit of the eliqible student.

- □ Primary School student rate \$125.00
- □ Secondary School student rate \$225 per year

The CSEF is paid directly to your child's school and will be allocated by the school towards camps, sports and/or excursion costs for your child.

How to Complete the Application Form

All sections must be completed by Parent/legal Guardian

- 1. Complete the Parent/Legal Guardian details section. Make sure that the Surname, first Name and customer Reference Number (CRN) details match those on your concession card. You will also need to provide your concession card to the school.
- 2. Complete the STUDENT DETAILS section for students at this school.
- 3. Sign and date the form and return to the office as soon as possible. he CSEF program for 2020 closes on 19 June 2020.

Any queries relating to CSEF eligibility and payments should be directed to the school office.
