### BOOKLIST, STATIONERY & TEXT BOOK ARRANGEMENTS

To ensure that every student has the essential books and stationery they need to learn effectively from day one of the 2024 school year, the College will again purchase book packs, stationery and textbooks for students from Foundation to Year 12.

Due to the different courses and combinations of subjects undertaken at each year level, arrangements are a little different across areas of the school.

**Foundation to Year 6** – bulk class materials are provided to the teacher for distribution to students in class during the course of the year.

**Year 7 to 10** – a stationery pack is provided for every student.

For elective subjects in Year 9 & 10 the teacher will provide the items needed by students. All textbooks are provided as class sets.

For Foundation to Year 10, parents are not required to purchase any books or stationery prior to the start of the year, however we do invite you to contribute towards the cost of the supplies by paying the attached Financial Contributions Schedule.

**Year 11 & 12 (and Year 10 students fast tracking a VCE subject)** – all students undertake different courses, so we are not able to provide a standard pack at this level. A recommended stationery list is attached, and you will be required to purchase the items for the subjects your child has chosen. Items are available from any office supplies store or supermarket.

We are however able to provide class sets of all textbooks, so families won't need to purchase these – class set text books are to be returned at the end of the year for use by other students the following year. Of course, you have the option of buying the textbooks, and not using class sets. A booklist will be issued as courses are confirmed for you to complete and forward to Champion Education if you wish to purchase your own.
