









The Grade 5/6 students have been enjoying learning about Inventions. Students have selected a topic or item of interest and are investigating how it was invented.

The program was highly successful and the overwhelming feedback from both students and employers has been extremely positive.



School for Student Leadership Walk for Mental Health

In Term 3 five Year 9 students attended the School for Student Leadership Marlo Campus. As part of the program students had to come up with a Community Learning Program (CLP). The Benalla group, composed of Erin Jenkins, Andrew Noyes, Mikayla Borradla, Alex Briggs and Sophie Winkler, chose to do a fundraiser for the Live4Life program here in Benalla. Students decided to do a 12 hour walk around Lake Benalla from 7am to 7pm, they created a fundraising page for people to donate to, spoke to local businesses for donations for the raffle and created publicity for the event by speaking to The Ensign and 3NF radio.

On Saturday 16th November the students each walked approximately 40 kms, along with over 90 members of the Benalla Community, ending the day with a celebration and the drawing of the raffle prizes. The group raised over nine thousand dollars, which is going to fund the Benalla Live4Life program which educates and empowers young people around teen mental health and suicide prevention and is a program that students from Benalla P12 have participated in for many years.


